

Cervical Biopsy

Discharge Instructions

- You may have light bleeding or spotting for 1 to 2 days.
- **Do not** put anything into your vagina, such as tampons or douches, or have intercourse for 2 days.

Call your health care provider if:

- you have any heavy bleeding (soaking a pad in an hour)
- you notice any unusual vaginal odour or discharge
- your temperature is higher than 38⁰C or 100.4⁰F
- you develop a rash, nausea and vomiting or diarrhea within a few days of the procedure.
