

Cryosurgery or Loop Electrocautery Excision Procedure (LEEP) Surgery

Discharge Instructions

- **Do not** put anything into your vagina such as tampons or douches, or have intercourse for 1 month.
- You may have a bath or shower, **do not** use bath oils or salts in the water.
- Your next menstrual period should be normal.
- After cryosurgery you may notice a watery discharge.

Call your health care provider if:

- you have any heavy bleeding (soaking a pad in an hour), or have severe cramps
- you notice an usual or foul odour or discharge
- your temperature is greater than 38°C or 100.4°F
- you develop a rash, nausea and vomiting, or diarrhea within a few days of the procedure
