

Early Pregnancy Assessment Clinic

Information about your referral

The Early Pregnancy Assessment Clinic (EPAC) is an outpatient clinic in the Women's Health Centre at the Regina General Hospital (RGH) and sees women **by referral** who:

- are early (less than 20 weeks) in their pregnancy who are having problems such as pain or bleeding
- have been diagnosed with a pregnancy loss, or miscarriage.

If you have been referred by your health care provider, a Registered Nurse from the clinic will contact you by telephone to arrange a time to be seen in the clinic.

What to Expect:

You must register through the System Wide Admission and Discharge Department (SWADD) **30 minutes before your appointment time** before each visit.

The length of time can vary at the clinic depending on the investigations needed and whether the physicians are needed on other units such as Labour and Birth. Please be prepared to stay 3 to 6 hours for your visit, during which time you:

- may have an ultrasound
- may have lab work
- will be seen by an Obstetrician Gynecologist and/or a medical Resident or medical student.

Please Bring to the Visit:

- Your Saskatchewan Health Services card
- A list of medications you are taking
- A support person
- A book to read or activity for yourself while you wait
- An interpreter, if you need one.

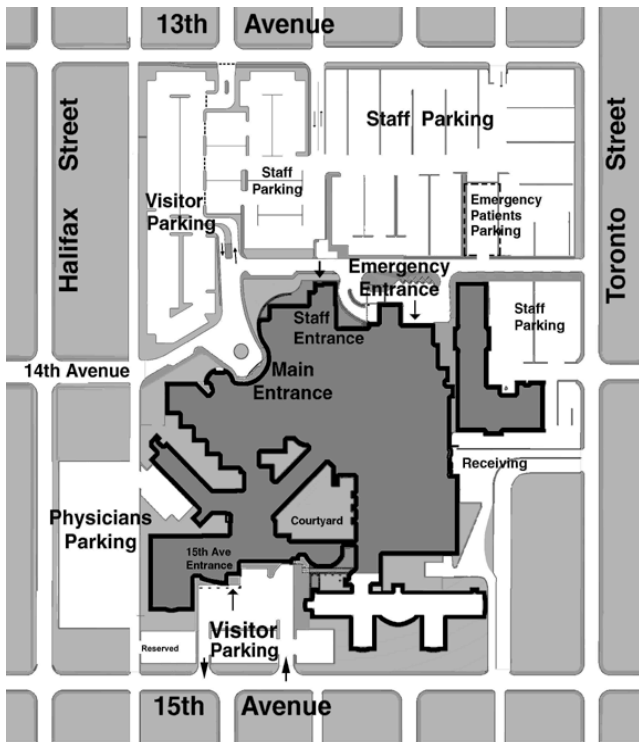

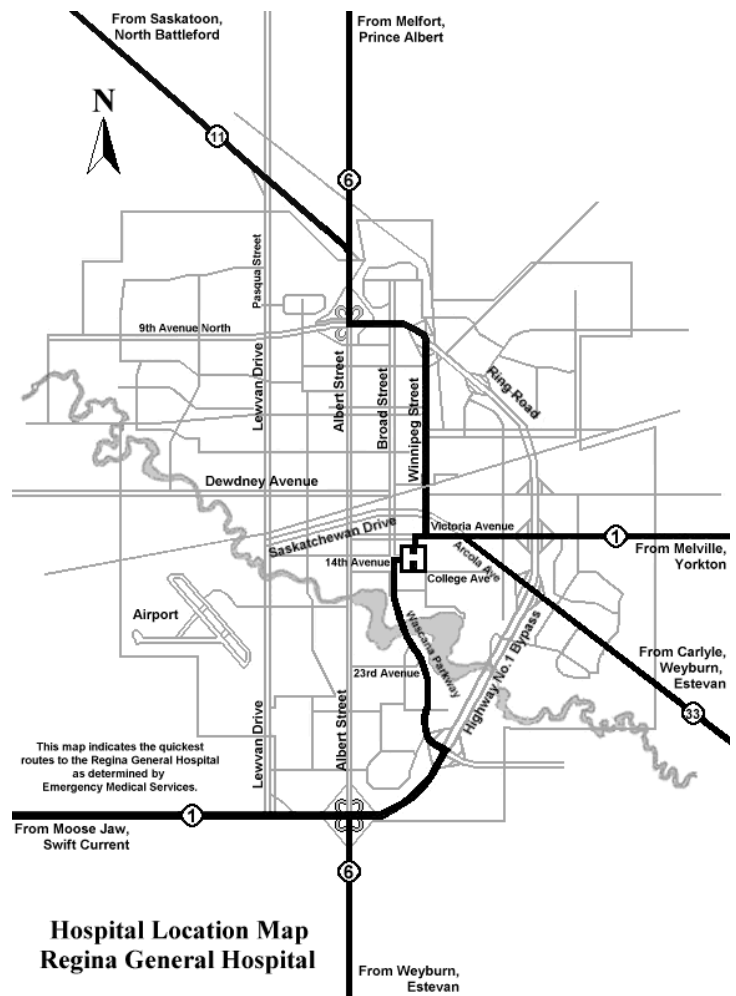


Regina General Hospital Parking Map
