- See staff for resident transport

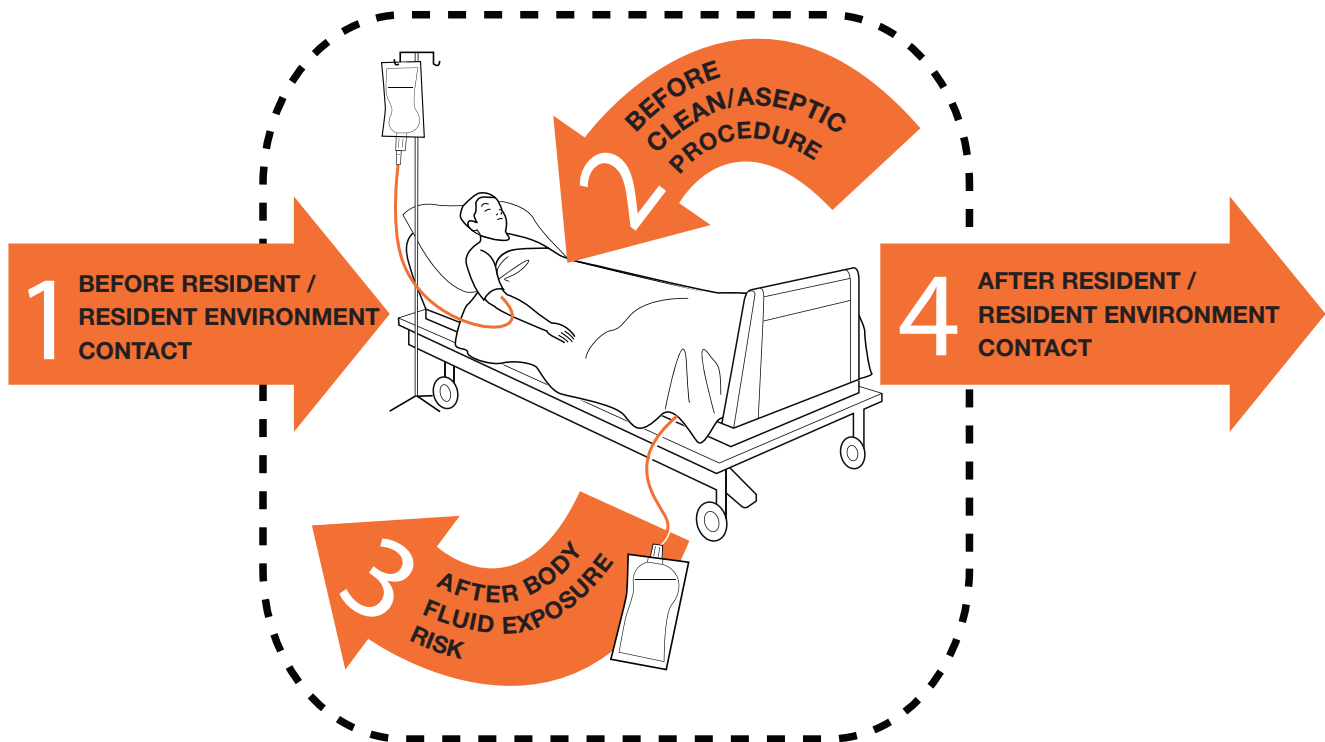
Isolation Cart Checklist

Gloves	Vinyl, Latex or Nitrile	Small, Medium, Large
Isolation Gowns	Reusable	Disposable if reusable not available
Masks	N95 Respirators and procedure masks	Various sizes available
Eye/Face Protection	Follow unit protocol	
Disinfectant Wipes	SANI-CLOTH® PLUS or ACCEL TB Wipes®	Use Accelerated Hydrogen Peroxide (e.g. Accel TB Wipes®) for suspected Norovirus
Alcohol-Based Hand Rub	Isagel® or Approved Replacement	
Inside Resident Room: Linen hamper, garbage can, alcohol based hand rub near exit		

Cleaning Requirements: Airborne & Contact Precautions

Daily Clean	Standard cleaning procedures
Terminal Clean	After discharge keep door closed for 1 hour Single clean using facility approved disinfectant unless otherwise specified by Infection Control or designate
