- See staff for resident transport

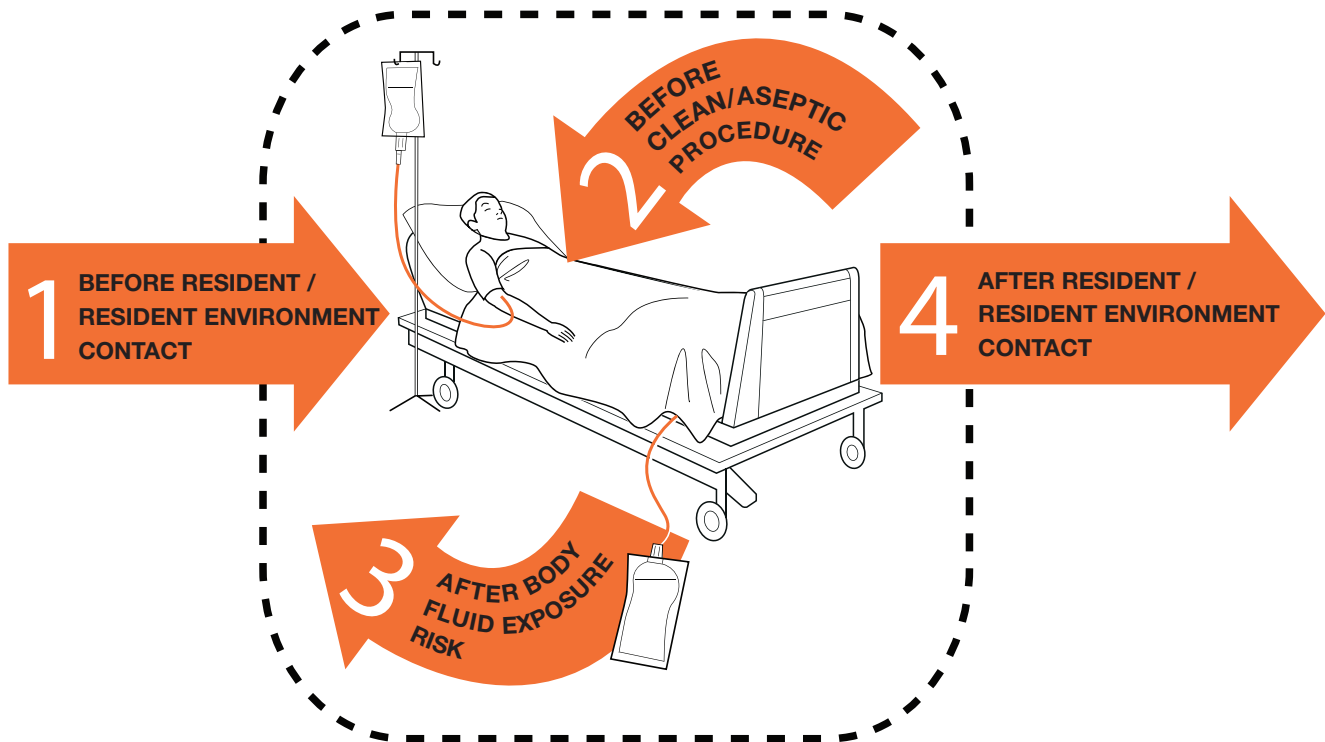
Isolation Cart Checklist

Gloves	Vinyl, Latex or Nitrile	Small, Medium, Large
Isolation Gowns	Reusable	Disposable if reusable not available
Masks	Procedure or Surgical	
Eye/Face Protection	Follow unit protocol	
Disinfectant Wipes	SANI-CLOTH® PLUS or ACCEL TB Wipes®	Use Accelerated Hydrogen Peroxide (e.g. Accel TB Wipes®) for suspected Norovirus
Alcohol-Based Hand Rub	Isagel® or Approved Replacement	
Inside Resident Room: Linen hamper, garbage can, alcohol based hand rub near exit		

Cleaning Requirements: Droplet & Contact Precautions

Daily Clean	Standard cleaning procedures
Terminal Clean	Single clean using facility approved disinfectant unless otherwise specified by Infection Control or designate
